Fishing:

Three signs have been produced setting out good practice for anglers and asking them to report any lost lines or weights. These are displayed at the top, middle and end of the pool.

Habitat Creation:

PL supplied a copy of a letter and quote from the AGA Group with a view to supplying 2-3 rafts. BT felt more investigation should be carried out what aquatic plants they would use before moving this forward and also suggested that recycled rafts be investigated.

It was agreed to include this on the next agenda.

Publicity:

PL has received a letter from Julia Goldsworthy MP congratulating the Forum on it's recent award from the Big Lottery Fund and requesting a visit. After a discussion the Forum decided that this could be good free publicity for the Nature Reserve. PL will make contact and make arrangements.
